- i. GENERAL: The California Cadet Corps is a leadership training program in an educational environment. This year, the selection for positions for encampment leadership will be based on those leaders deemed trustworthy enough to lead the training of cadets, ranging from the Battalion, Company, and Platoon Levels. Chosen leaders will have the rare opportunity to make a difference in the specific training for their units and work hands-on to develop strong leaders in more junior cadets; impacting the CACC for future generations.
- ii. PARTICIPATION: Applying as Cadre for Leadership Encampment is available to any cadet, with the only requirement being to hold the rank of <u>C/SGT</u> NLT June 2024. We will hold all Encampment cadre to the same standards and expectations as the 10th Corps staff, thus filling out this application does not guarantee you to be a part of the Leadership Encampment cadre. Note that if you sign up for a position, you <u>MUST</u> participate in ADVON from 16-18JUN24, Leadership Camp from 19-22JUN24 and Advanced Camp from 22-29JUN24.
- iii. AVAILABLE POSITIONS: All requirements and job descriptions from CR 3-22 and CR 3-3 will apply. The following positions are available to all eligible cadets for the 2023 Summer Encampment.
 - a. Instructional Block Cadre
 - i. Be an instructor for one of the 6 leadership encampment instructional blocks. [PT/O-Course, Drill & Ceremonies, Land Navigation, Leadership Reaction Course, Map Reading, and First Aid]
 - b. Battalion Commander
 - c. Battalion Executive Officer
 - d. Battalion Command Sergeant Major
 - e. Battalion Medic*(Cadets Selected for this position **MUST** have gone through the previous Cadet Medic Course offered at Summer Encampment)
 - i. Battalion Medics may also be asked to serve as Advanced Unit Medics. Medics will still be able to participate in training, however utilized when needed.
 - f. Company Commander
 - g. Company First Sergeant
 - h. HQ Support Officer/NCO
 - i. Advanced Unit OIC

- i. This position is available for high school cadets only
- iv. APPLICATION PACKET: All applications will be filled out at the following link: <u>https://forms.office.com/r/yXULjjaBMr</u> NLT 1 March 2024. Consider that while we will do our best to place you in one of your top three positions, you will ultimately be placed where you can best serve at the commander's pleasure and, regardless of where you are placed, you will receive an excellent leadership opportunity.
 - A commandant/senior leader recommendation is highly encouraged for cadets seeking leadership positions at any level. Commandants can either create a letter of recommendation <u>OR</u> fill out the following form here: <u>https://forms.office.com/r/UHVMqQqExf</u> to recommend a cadet in lieu of a letter of recommendation.
- v. REQUIRED ATTENDANCE: Along with the Participation Requirements, cadet leaders who wish to be on the Battalion Command Staff or an OIC for Advanced Encampment **MUST** attend the April and May HQ Drills either in-person at San Luis Obispo or virtually via Microsoft Teams. This drill is crucial for finalizing planning for the encampment and will prepare the leaders in a thorough manner. Transportation to the drill will not be provided, therefore meaning that cadets either must travel with their commandant (or a local one) to attend in person.
- vi. UNIFORM: The uniform for this event will be the Class C & PT Uniform.
- vii. COST: Summer Encampment Application Fee (\$150). All cadet cadre **MUST** register through the Summer Encampment application portal when it is opened in February 2024.
- viii. REGISTRATION: Registration for Summer Encampment Cadre can be accomplished by filling out the online registration form at: <u>https://forms.office.com/r/yXULjjaBMr</u>
 - a. Note: EVEN IF YOU SIGN UP FOR CADET CADRE, YOU STILL NEED TO REGISTER THROUGH THE SUMMER CAMP APPLICATION, WHICH WILL BE OPEN ON 01FEB24 ON THE CACC WEBSITE.
