

WARNING ORDER: 010-2324-012

1) SITUATION:

- a) Name: Adult Fieldcraft Instructor Course (AFIC)
- b) Dates: 11-14 March 2024.
- c) Start and End Times: Event starts 11 March 2024 at 1200 HRS and ends 14 March 2024 at 1000 HRS.
- d) Location: Camp San Luis Obispo (CSLO)
- e) Participation Requirements:
 - (1) Enrollment is open to CACC/CSG/YP SAD adults physically capable of operating and sleeping in an outdoor environment during the training.

2) MISSION: California Cadet Corps (CACC) will conduct the Adult Fieldcraft Instructor Course IOT train personnel to facilitate survival/wilderness training at their home unit and/or perform as Survival and Wilderness Skills Course staff.

3) EXECUTION:

- a) Intent: Provide safe, in-depth instruction of outdoor skills in a field environment.
- b) Concept of Operations:
 - (1) Participants will report to CACC HQ, 10 Sonoma Ave BLDG 1301, Camp San Luis Obispo, CA 93405 NLT 1200 HRS on 11 March 2024.
 - (2) Upon arrival, adults will check-in, receive a safety brief, and be issued necessary equipment.
 - (3) Once in-processing is complete, personnel will move to a remote base-camp setting where all training will be conducted.
 - (4) When training is completed, personnel will return to CSLO and turn-in their equipment.
 - (5) The event will conclude NLT 1000 HRS on 14 March 2024.
- c) Application Process: Adults should register using the application portal at <https://CACCFieldcraftInstructorCourse.eventbrite.com>
- d) Cost: The \$50 enrollment fee covers the training materials utilized during the event.
 - (1) A payment method must be selected during the application process.
 - (2) Payment may be completed online during the registration process or by check turned-in at in-processing.
 - (3) Approved AFIC support staff and instructors must register for the course using the "Facilitator Registration (AFIC Staff) ticket"; personnel must coordinate with the Course Manager prior to using this registration method to ensure they have been accepted in a staff role.
- e) Duty Status: CACC/CSG personnel will be in a Temporary SAD duty status for the event; CACC personnel must submit a [travel order request](#) before attendance.
- f) Key Suspense Dates:
 - (1) Application portal closes: 4 March 2024

(2) Payment due 11 March 2024

- g) Uniforms: Adults are not required to report in uniform. Civilian clothing appropriate for outdoor training in a field environment is authorized.
- h) Certificate of Completion: A certificate will be awarded annotating 36-hours of professional development for the course.
- i) Packing List: Participants will be Emailed a packing list once their application is accepted.

4) SUSTAINMENT:

- a) Transportation will not be provided for this event; traveling to and from CSLO is the participant's responsibility.
 - (1) Secure parking and support vehicles are available for anyone who does not want to utilize their vehicle during the event; all training areas can be accessed by unimproved road.
- b) Participants will receive prepared meals and will be issued all necessary equipment during the event.

- b) Instructors & Assignments: Instructors will be assigned based on experience and/or attendance at previous Outdoor Adventure Training events. - c) Participants accepted into the course will receive a welcome letter and packing list via Email and updates via Microsoft Teams.
